Thank you to all who made the picnic possible through donations and volunteerism!

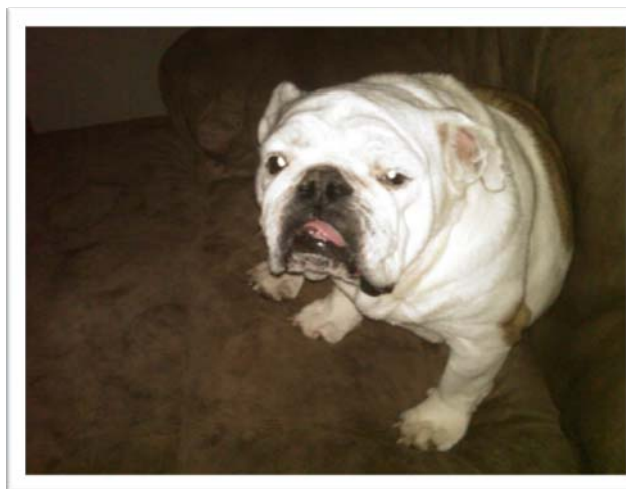

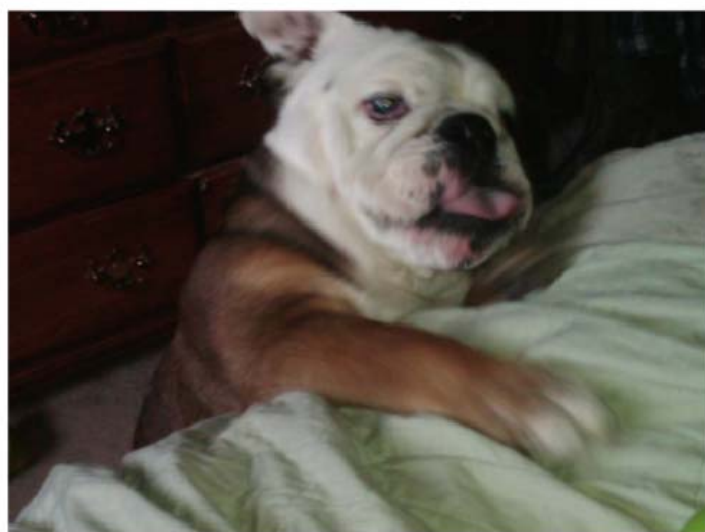
DEAR RITA,

out at the picnic and taking photos of August and Kona, Adele, Brutus, Yahtzee and Nono.

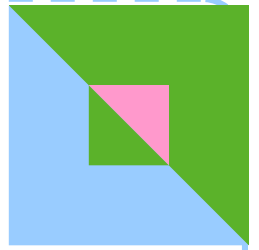

they felt keeping Tilly was an accident waiting to happen.

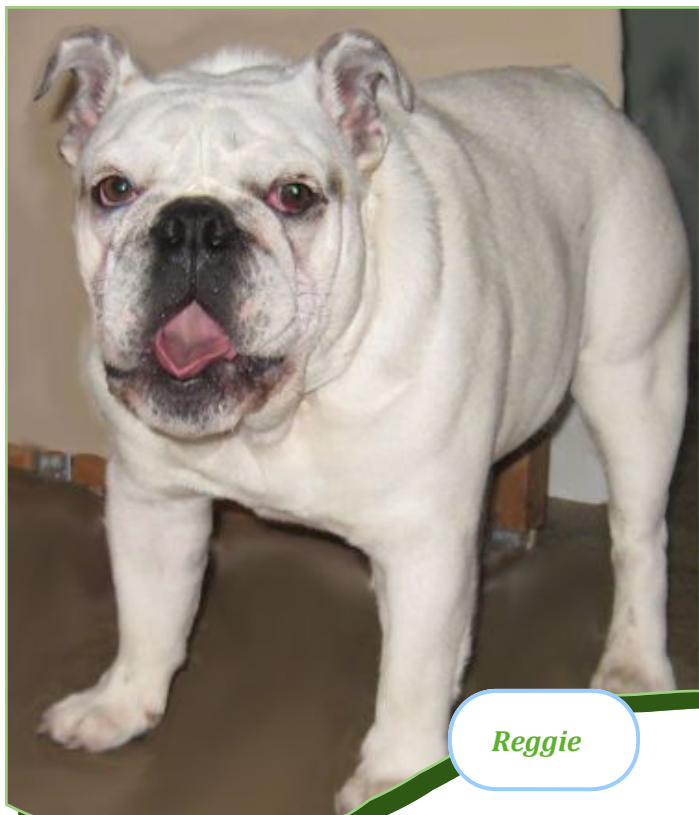

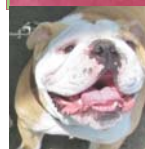
