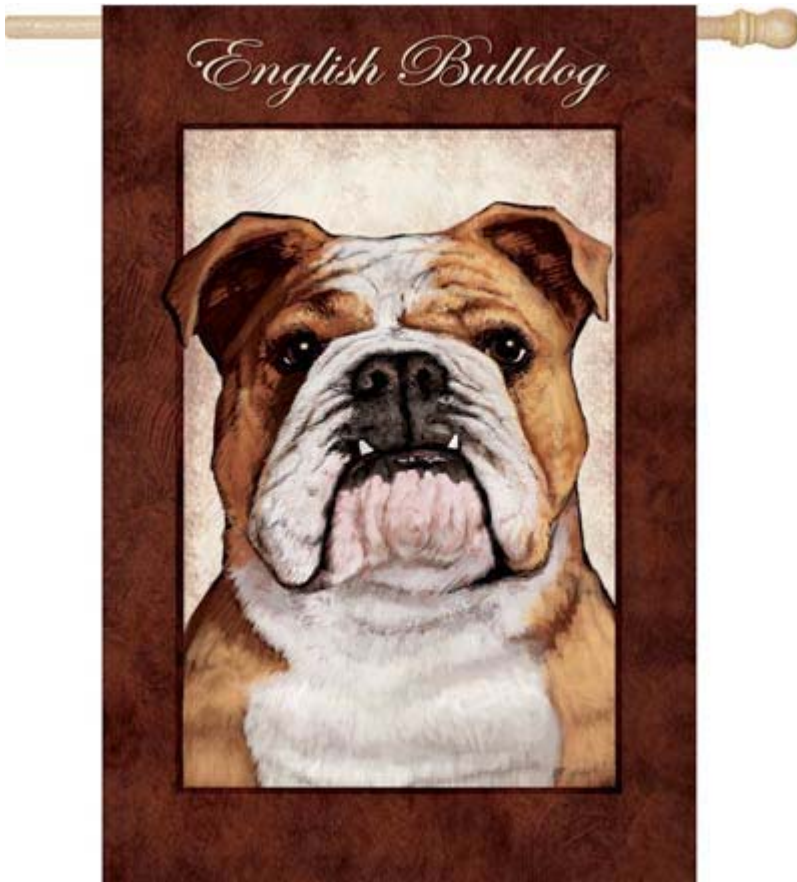

So she ended up getting Max back, but due to housing regulations could not keep him for more than a few days. Max went to the Inver Grove Heights Animal Hospital for a visit as he needed boosters on vaccinations and also needed to be heartworm checked. Other than an ear infection and mild eye infection, for which he was given medication, Max was given a clean bill of health. Max is being fostered by Jey and Justine. Once we have a better idea of Max’s personality, we will begin the process of finding him his forever home.

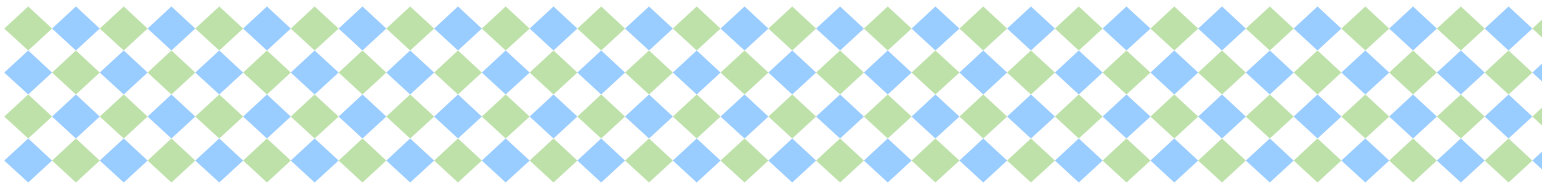
What do you do to keep your dog occupied or entertained when you are at work?
